Changes in issues (new journals)</li><li>3. New "watchers" (user added as a watcher)</li></ol> Actually Redmine supports much more "objects":  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Issue added</li><li>2. Issue updated</li><li>3. News added</li><li>4. Document added</li><li>5. File added</li><li>6. Message added</li><li>7. Wiki page added</li><li>8. Wiki page updated</li></ol> So Orangutan should also support them!  Currently it is not a big problem because most of "objects" are disabled (no notifications about them by email)... But...
