<b>Description</b> UnfinishedTask context depends on status changes. It seems (need to check) that currently Orangutan “forgets” status changes after restart and does not ask a user to stop/break the task as expected. Perhaps in Init event it is possible to “recover” status changes and insert UnfinishedTask.
