<b>Description</b> <p>Many applications contain script configure which is intended to check if the application can be successfully installed. OpenSWAN contains ipsec verify tool to check the installation etc. I guess such script needs to be done for Orangutan.</p> <p>Let's name it check.</p> <p>The check should verify the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Which supported Redmine plugins are installed (and which is not), what should be changed to support installed plugins;</li><li>• Whether all fields were added (migration scripts were launched);</li><li>• Check if views were not outdated;</li><li>• Check if bulk_time_entries_time_entry.html.erb.patch were applied and recommend to apply if not;</li><li>• etc.</li></ul> <p>It can also check:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If Jabber IDs are ok, can recommend to enable SSL/TLS etc;</li><li>• Whether all directories are readable/writable by Orangutan user.</li></ul>
