<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>Right now Orangutan notifies users about changes made to issues etc. But... There are several problems here:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. If Orangutan crashes it won't notify about changes made until crash (if he have not yet) – that is Orangutan should save the “pool” of notifications somewhere;</li><li>2. It does not take into account user's Redmine notification settings (see <a href="#">#1029</a>);</li><li>3. It does not send everything in a pool to a user – it sends only notifications less than 5 days old.</li></ol> <p>I'm not sure about the last. Are you interested in getting notifications older than 5 days?!..</p> <p>If this should be done better I guess to inform users about older notifications this way:</p> <pre>Orangutan: ... &lt;Actual notification 1&gt; ...
