<b>Description</b> <p>Currently this is just an idea... To illustrate here is what I do often:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Speak with a person by email;</li><li>• When needed (before going to vocation or when I find it too complicated to search mail all the time) I “transfer” (Copy + Paste) messages to Redmine.</li></ul> <p>Theoretically it's possible to automate this. One could write an application hosting on Google Apps which would suggest (or just do) copying message content to Redmine. The algo should be like this:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An application is triggered when some of conditions are met (e.g. contact email).</li><li>• It checks messages and depending on configuration:</li><li>• Automatically copies message content to remote Redmine or...</li><li>• Shows a button to do this.</li><li>• On Redmine REST API controller receives a message;</li><li>• Then detects an issue and...</li><li>• Adds a message as a note (or as a special other object).</li></ul> <p>Some links:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="http://code.google.com/apis/gmail/gadgets/contextual/">http://code.google.com/apis/gmail/gadgets/contextual/</a> - Perhaps this can be used</li></ul>
