The attached patch ensures that the repository identifier and the repository patch match, ensuring Redmine's repository lookup will work; *"/path/<proj.identifier>"* for repositories without identifier, and *"/path/<proj.identifier>.<repo.identifier>"* for repositories with an identifier (sub-repositories in Redmine's parlance).
