<b>Description</b>	
Currently the flow is:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In Redmine in the project settings we open the Modules tab and enable the “Blog” module.</li><li>• After this the new “Blog” tab appears in the project menu.</li><li>• But clicking the tab renders 404 (not found) error...</li></ul>	
This happens as this project has not being imported yet!	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To import the project (i.e., to synchronize all projects, actually) we just need to <u>open</u> the new post page (no need to post anything)...</li></ul>	
And it would be fantastic if opening the project blog index page triggered the import of the project into WordPress!	
But I did not find how this could be done... Certainly, the <code>get_term_by()</code> function is used by the project index. But this function does not support filters or actions... Probably, it is used by <code>get_queried_object()</code> but this one also does not come with filters nor actions. So ideas needed!..
