**Description**

Currently, the plugin supports external links using the syntax like `[[redmine>#9638]]` (this one generates a link to the corresponding [Redmine](#) issue)..

I also think about adding support for, e.g., `[[debian>#9638]]`... The problem is that not every customer will need to have links to Debian issues.

A good alternative is to support custom links, syntax of which can be configured. Thus, the plugin can come with a form like:

Create a syntax for external links in format: `[[keyword>#value]]`

**Keyword**

**Link values to URL**

This way every customer will be able to add as many custom issues links as he needs.
