<b>Description</b> <p>Sometimes I want to mark issues, that I want to work on on high priority. It's not enough to remember them, as I can have no time to start working on them during months. So, obviously, it's not possible to remember their numbers.</p> <p>In this case, it would be great to have the possibility to "star" such issue.</p> <p>I was thinking about implementing something like this using special custom fields (and already started to do something), but then I realized, that this should be a separate plugin. Thus, custom fields won't allow me to have the "Starred issues" block on "My page".</p> <p>Other requirements/ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The star should be in the right top corner of the issue page (below "Previous"/"Next" links).</li><li>• The star should be displayed in the issue list, i.e., it should be supported by the issue query.</li></ul>
