Escaping ISSUE-id's special Textile syntax rule does not work, if multiple IDs are specified in one line. For example:			
<code>!#ISSUE-1, !#ISSUE-2 and !#ISSUE-3</code>			
Demo: #ISSUE-1, #ISSUE-2 and #ISSUE-3			
This happens because Redmine treats !#ISSUE-1, ! as an image. Therefore, <code>parse_redmine_links_with_issue_id</code> gets the following text:			
Demo: <code>#ISSUE-2 and !#ISSUE-3</code>			
The same applies to legacy IDs:			
Demo: #1, #2 and #3			
So, it's not a problem in the plugin, but in the Redmine core.
