<b>Description</b>			
<p>To optimize load of /mentions/autocomplete I set the debounce option of <a href="#">jQuery textcomplete</a> to 500 ms. This should have made the autocomplete function be called with the delay.</p> <p>In practice, however, with this option set the autocomplete function sometimes is not getting called at all, ever. Usually, this happens, when I put just @ or user:, i.e., a user link without any term (without a part of login, name or identifier). If, however, I add any character and then remove it (i.e., get the same @ or user: in result), the autocomplete gets executed.</p> <p>If I remove the debounce option, everything works as expected. This makes me think, that the problem is in how jQuery textcomplete handles the debounce.</p>

In [r94](#) I made it possible to configure the debounce. By default, it's 500 ms, so the bug takes place. As a workaround users can set it to 0, in this way disabling it. However, this will increase load of /mentions/autocomplete.
