<b>Description</b> Orangutan utilizes data from database fields and tables created by third-party (not default) Redmine plugins. This means that if some table or field is missing Orangutan will fail to work with database. This is normal for <a href="#">Softjour</a> n usage but if Orangutan is going to be used by others Orangutan should be able to detect which plugins are available and to act correspondingly.
