The main question is how to implement this... It seems like these should be queries like the following:

```
You: Edit comment #2 of #146
You: Edit last comment of #146
```

Currently comments (during output) are numbered taking into account only their position in history. Unlike Orangutan Redmine numbers not just comments but changes (journals). I'm afraid that there can be a confusion - saying a user sees comments he wants to change in Redmine having number [#15](#). He can assume that this number is the same for Orangutan. So perhaps numbering in Orangutan should be changed to be identical to Redmine.
